

# Speedy Sporty Beanie

An Anti-Craft Pattern



## Materials

- Any Chunky yarn to get correct tension (I used 2 strands of 8ply/DK)
- Pair of 7mm needles

## Gauge

13 stitches x 16 rows to 10cm square

## Measurements

Small: Width 18.5" (47cm), Height 7" (17.5cm)  
Medium: Width 20.5" (52cm), Height 8" (20cm)  
Large: Width 22.5" (57cm), Height 8.5" (21.5cm)  
X-Large: Width 22.5" (57cm), Height 10" (25cm)  
Measured from crown to fold line on brim



## Instructions - 2-colour

### Ribbed band

Using colour 1:

Cast on 60 (66, 72, 72) stitches

Work 14 (16, 20, 20) rows of knit 3, purl 3 rib

### Main body

Using colour 1: work 0 (2, 2, 6) rows stocking stitch (knit right side rows, purl wrong side rows)

Using colour 2: work 4 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 1: work 2 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 2: work 4 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 1: work 4 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 2: work 4 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 1: work 2 (2, 4) rows stocking stitch

[20 (22, 22, 28) rows total]

## Shape crown

*Size S only*

Using colour 2:

Row 1: k3, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 2: purl

Row 3: k2, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 4: purl

Using colour 1

Row 5: k1, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 6: purl

Row 7: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 8: purl

Row 9: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

*Size M & L only*

Using colour 2:

Row 1: k4, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 2: purl

Row 3: k3, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 4: purl

Using colour 1:

Row 5: k2, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 6: purl

Row 7: k1, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 8: purl

Row 9: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 10: purl

Row 11: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

*All sizes:*

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread the yarn through the stitches on the needle, draw up tight and then sew up the back seam. Sew in all ends. Fold over band.

# 1-colour



## Instructions - 1-colour

### Ribbed band

Cast on 60 (66, 72, 72) stitches

Work 14 (16, 20, 20) rows of knit 3, purl 3 rib

### Main body

Work 20 (22, 22, 28) rows stocking stitch (knit right side rows, purl wrong side rows)

### Shape crown

*Size S only*

Row 1: k3, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 2: purl

Row 3: k2, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 4: purl

Using colour 1

Row 5: k1, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 6: purl

Row 7: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 8: purl

Row 9: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

*Size M, L & XL*

Row 1: k4, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 2: purl

Row 3: k3, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 4: purl

Using colour 1:

Row 5: k2, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 6: purl

Row 7: k1, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 8: purl

Row 9: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 10: purl

Row 11: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

*All sizes:*

Finish as per 2-colour beanie

# 3-colour



## Instructions - 3-colour

### Main body

Using colour 1: work 0 (2, 2, 8) rows stocking stitch (knit right side rows, purl wrong side rows)

Using colour 2: work 2 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 3: work 4 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 1: work 6 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 3: work 4 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 2: work 2 rows stocking stitch

Using colour 1: work 0 (2, 4) rows stocking stitch  
[20 (22, 22, 28) rows total]

### Shape crown

*Size S only*

Using colour 1:

Row 1: knit 3, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 2: purl

Row 3: knit 2, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 4: purl

Row 5: knit 1, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 6: purl

Row 7: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 8: purl

Row 9: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

*Size M, L & XL*

Using colour 1:

Row 1: knit 4, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 2: purl

Row 3: knit 3, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 4: purl

Row 5: knit 2, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 6: purl

Row 7: knit 1, k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 8: purl

Row 9: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

Row 10: purl

Row 11: k2tog \* repeat to end of row

*All sizes:*

Finish as per 2-colour beanie
